Job Duties: Duties may include but are not limited to:

### Supervision and Administrative

- Hire, train and supervise groundskeeping staff (3 FT, 2 PT)
- Serve on senior management team and manage department budget
- Maintain vendor relationships (security, trash, pest control, etc.)
- Achieve all safety, health, security, and USDA regulations
- Serve as liaison to and work with City of Sacramento's William Land Park staff

#### Facilities Management

- Maintain park playsets and buildings including Welcome Center, Story Center, Barn Office, Castle and Children's Theater
- Manage HVAC, plumbing, electrical, irrigation system, janitorial, auto maintenance

### **Grounds Management**

Beautify and maintain 3.5 acre property – playsets, gardens, picnic areas, fences, etc.
